ABOUT THE REGATTA

This summer's NC Governor's Cup Regatta is the 48th to be held since its inauguration in 1957, distinguishing it as one of the oldest, largest, and most venerable in the Southeast. The regatta includes up to five races sailed over two days. It takes place off Henderson Point on Kerr Lake, which is known for its expanse of open inland water and beautiful tree-lined shores.

The NC Governor's Cup is more than a Carolina tradition. A number of one-design fleets include the regatta in their district circuit competitions and SAYRA One Design Championship, attracting some of the best sailors in the country. This year we are adding an OPTI course and are inviting red, white, blue and green fleets.

Your host is the Carolina Sailing Club, promoting one-design competition in the South East. We are honored and delighted to welcome you to this historic regatta.

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

The Carolina Sailing Club invites you to a continental breakfast on Saturday and Sunday mornings. Sailors and guests are invited to a social after Saturday's races. Following the Social will be a dinner. One dinner is included with registration. Each additional adult dinner is \$15. One child's hot dog and hamburger dinner is included with OPTI registration. Other child dinners are available for \$7. Those 3 years and under eat free.

DIRECTIONS

Henderson Point State Recreation Area is located on Kerr Lake near the Virginia-North Carolina border about 15 miles north of Henderson, NC. From I-85 or US 1 at Henderson, follow NC 39 north. Two miles north of Townsville, turn right onto SR 1356. Then, about 3 miles further, turn right on to SR 1359. Follow signs to the Henderson Point State Recreation Area.

FEES AND REGISTRATION

Payment by credit card is available with preregistration until 06/10/04 at www.layline.com under Regatta Registration. Please mail the completed registration form or bring it with you.

Discounted fees are offered for prepaid registration postmarked or ordered on the web by 06/10/04, and for US Sailing members.

Five boats in a class must be registered by 10:30 a.m. on June 18 to qualify for separate scoring and trophies for that class. Late registrations may be allowed at the scorekeeper's discretion, but late registrants will not affect the number of separate classes scored.

All those pre-registered must go through the registration process at the Regatta. Also, all participants, including crew, must sign a release waiver.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Henderson Point is not near fast food or convenience stores. Make sure to bring enough food, water, and other drinks you may need.
- There currently is construction of piers at the Henderson Point site. If this construction is not completed we will change the venue to Jordan Lake. Watch the CSC web site www.carolinasailingclub.org for information on a venue change.

JURISDICTION AND RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the **rules** as defined in the **Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008**. The Regatta is a **Category A**. Sailing instructions will be provided at registration.

CLASS COMPETITION

The Carolina Sailing Club welcomes one-design centerboard and catamaran classes to compete for the 2005 NC Governor's Cup. Five boats registered in a given class will guarantee scoring and a trophy for that class. Invited classes include, but are not limited to:

Buccaneer	Lightning	Isotope	Tanzer 16

We will divide these fleets into two courses.

There will be a separate course for:

Optimist (Red, White, Blue and Green fleets)

Fleets of fewer than 5 boats per class will compete under U. S. Sailing Portsmouth or PHRF handicapping rules in:

Open Monohull Open Multi-hull Open PHRF
Judgments, exceptions, and adjustments to handicaps will be at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

SCORING AND TROPHIES

Fleet trophies will be awarded according to the low-point scoring system of Appendix A4. A boat's series score will be the total of all her race scores. This changes RRS A.2. Five races are scheduled; one race is required to constitute a regatta.

Trophies will be awarded to a class based on the number of boats in a class.

(1) 1-5 boats, (2) 5-8 boats, (3) 9-12 boats,
(4) 13-16 boats, (5) 17-20, (6) 21 boats and over.

All Optimist green fleet sailors will receive participation awards.

The NC Governor's Cup is a perpetual trophy engraved with the name of the skipper in his/her class having the best average score based on a high-point system. A keeper trophy will also be presented.
